USA and PA All-Star Team Line-Up Changes

Women's PA and USA Showcase Match

See Three High School All-Star Duals Meets for One Admission

Pittsburgh, PA – There are two changes to the feature dual meet between the PA versus USA All-Stars, and an exhibition match in the [Pittsburgh Wrestling Classic](#), presented by U.S. Steel.

Michael Mocco, ranked 3rd by [FloWrestling](#) at 285 lbs., withdrew due to scheduling conflicts. He's replaced by Cliff Nicholson, III, on the USA All-Stars. Nicholson, from Medina, OH, is an Ohio State Champion with a 156-33 career record.

Nicholson will wrestle Dean Bechtold, from Owen J. Roberts High School. Bechtold is ranked 4th in the country at 285 and is a 2X time Champion.

Brandt Harer, ranked 4th at 145 lbs., was forced to withdraw due to a severe ankle injury. His replacement is Michael Turi, a 3X PIAA state place winner for West Scranton High School. This year Turi wrestled for Wyoming Seminary and was the National runner-up.

Turi will face #1 ranked Kellen Wolbert, from Wisconsin. Wolbert is a 4X state champion with a career record of 195-3.

Due to the misalignment in the women's Pennsylvania vs Oklahoma line-ups an opportunity surfaced to showcase two of the country's best wrestlers in a PA vs USA match.

Pennsylvania's Bryce Synder, ranked 3rd at 170 lbs. will wrestle #6 ranked Elizabeth Madison, from Loveland, OH, at the conclusion of the women's PA versus OK dual meet.

Synder is a 1X PIAA State Champion with a 100-21 career record from Palisades High School. Madison is a 3X Ohio state champion, with a career record of 143-2.
